Our facility is open 365 days a year and volunteer shifts are available Monday-Sunday, year round. We require a minimum commitment of 3 hours per week for 1 year months (with allowances for personal time off). Depending on time of year and animals in care, the shifts may be available to start as early as 7:30am and some start later in the day and end as late as 9pm. We need people passionate about our work and willing to make a long-term commitment to being trained and working as a volunteer. Therefore, we do not accept applications seeking court-ordered community service hours. All volunteers must be 18 years of age or older.
