



Volunteer Program Application

Our hospital runs 7 days a week, 365 days a year, to ensure daily care of our patients. While positions may be recruiting year-round, our busiest time of the year is March through October.

We are happy to be adding two NEW volunteer positions at Second Chance, beginning in Spring of 2026. These new roles, described below, will directly help support our mission to provide compassionate care to injured, sick, and orphaned wildlife, while educating the public on how they can help wildlife. While these roles are not directly involved in animal care, they may provide advancement opportunities for committed volunteers interested in an Animal Care Volunteer position.

- **Greeter Volunteer**

This role creates a compassionate and professional first point of contact for individuals visiting or contacting SCWC. Greeters support patient intake by welcoming rescuers, answering phones, responding to emails, assisting the Admissions Team with patient admissions, and helping with data entry into our patient database.

- **Housekeeping Volunteer**

This role supports the health and safety of wildlife patients, staff, interns, and fellow volunteers by maintaining a clean, organized, safe, and sanitary clinic environment. This position is ideal for individuals who want to support wildlife rehabilitation behind the scenes and make a meaningful impact, without direct animal handling.

All volunteer positions are a minimum of one 4-hour shift per week, for a minimum 6-month commitment. Shift start and end times as well as more detailed information about each volunteer position are listed in the website descriptions.
